EuroWindowor reminds the Commission to the “Energy Efficiency First” principle regarding the action plan for heat pumps



Frankfurt, June 2023 - EuroWindowor did ask for a balanced approach between efficiency of building envelope and use of renewable energy when giving its feedback to the consultation on the action plan to accelerate roll-out of heat pumps across the EU. The use of high-performance windows does reduce energy demand and allowed eating by less power-consuming heat pumps in a cost-optimal way preventing from electrical power shortage.

Frankfurt, July 2023 – EuroWindowor, the European association of windows, doors and façade manufacturers, welcomes the draft delegated directive enabling the use of recovered post-consumer rigid PVC in plastic profiles of electrical and electronic windows and doors. EuroWindowor commends the efforts to harmonize European legislations but emphasizes the need for alignment and clarification to facilitate a smoother regulatory process.
