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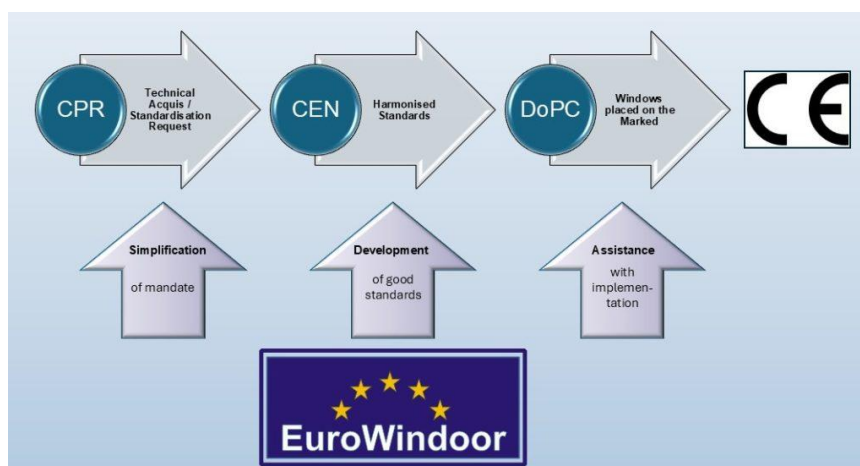
EuroWindoor advocates for a balanced and cost-efficient role of Notified Bodies in the new CPR

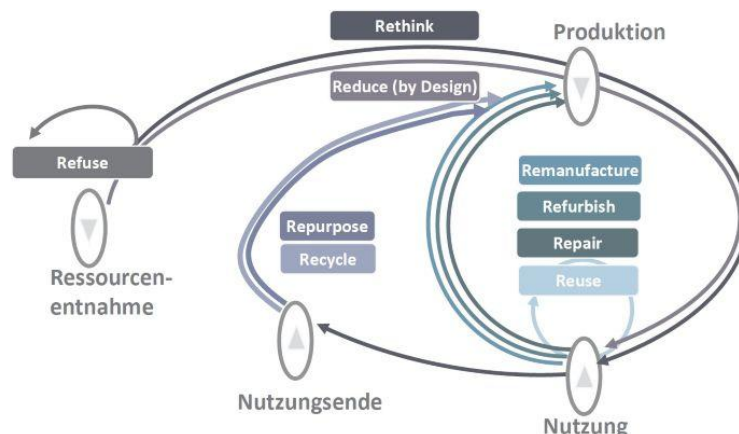
EuroWindoor met DG GROW representative in Brussels to discuss key challenges of the new CPR
